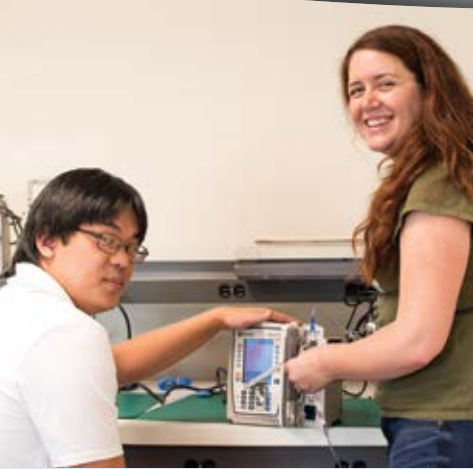

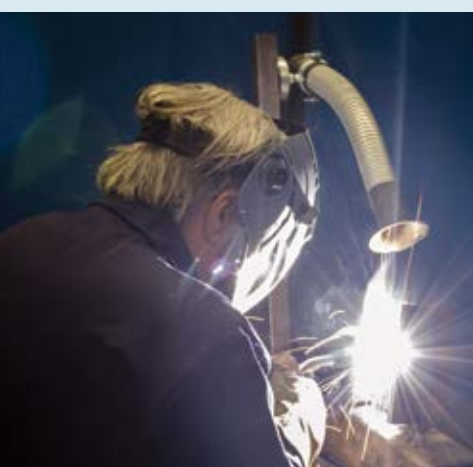

Your learning options

Face-to-face

- Scheduled in-person time in class
- Vaccination is required for in-person classes (exception for medical or religious reasons)



Online

- All coursework done online
- No scheduled class meetings, allowing you to learn at your convenience
- Interact with instructor and classmates on our own time
- Learning activities and assignments must be submitted by due dates

Hybrid

- Part online without a set time to attend, part scheduled class time
- Scheduled class time will be face-to-face on campus
- Primarily for lab science, physical education and occupational classes



Livestream

- Sessions meet online at specific days and times
- Interact live with instructor and classmates in a virtual environment
- Online assignments with due dates to be completed outside of class session

Board Policy 5210: Communicable Disease

The MiraCosta Community College District is committed to providing a safe and healthy campus. The district shall establish administrative procedures necessary to assure cooperation with local public health officials in measures necessary for the prevention and control of communicable diseases. SARS-CoV-2 and the disease it causes, COVID-19, is a global pandemic and has resulted in widespread illness and death worldwide, in the United States, and in California. In furtherance of this commitment, the district shall establish administrative procedures regarding COVID-19 vaccination to mitigate the risks surrounding exposure to COVID-19. These administrative procedures will require that all students who are on district premises for any face-to-face instructional and student support activities (e.g., office hours, classes, library, tutoring, etc.) have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19. The district will accept any COVID-19 vaccine that has been Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Emergency Use Authorized (EUA) and/or has been approved by the World Health Organization (WHO). PARKING INFORMATION

Parking permits normally required at MiraCosta College campuses in Oceanside, San Elijo and the Community Learning Center have been waived for fall 2021 semester in student parking lots ONLY. College police will be enforcing parking requirements in staff parking lots or spots, and disabled parking spaces. Parking is always free at the Technology Career Institute.

The San Elijo Campus of MiraCosta College is closed due to extensive remodeling and other construction projects. It is scheduled to reopen just in time for the spring 2022 semester.

REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY

Check refunds may take 4–6 weeks to process.

Class/Workshop Refund Policy: Refunds will be made up to three business days prior to the class start date. No refunds will be given once a class has started. A \$15 cancellation fee will be retained for each refund. A full refund will be given if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment. Unused attendance is not transferable to another class session.

Excursion Refund Policy: Refunds will be made up to five business days before the excursion only if the excursion is full and someone on the waiting list is available to take your place. There will be a \$25 cancellation fee if a replacement can be found.

Workforce Training Refund Policy: Refunds will be made up to five business days, depending on course, prior to the class start date. A \$75 cancellation fee for work skills programs will be retained for each refund. A full refund will be given if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment. Unused attendance is not transferable to another class session.

Class/Workshop Transfer Policy: Transfers will be approved up to three business days prior to the class start date. Students must receive a verbal approval from Community Education before a transfer can be made.

NEW Intro to Adobe Lightroom-Photo Editing

Do you have a bunch of digital photos on your iPhone or DSLR camera which need some minor editing or improvements which you would then like to post on Social Media or share with your loved ones? If so, this course is for you. Adobe Lightroom will be used for the photo editing portion of this class, and includes: Corrections (Exposure, highlights, shadows, whites, blacks, vibrancy, etc.), Coloring (Tone Curve, HSL color correction, split toning, etc.) and Finishing (Lens correction, sharpening, cropping, etc.). Whether you're interested in using Lightroom for editing specific styles of photography, like landscape shots, or want a more broad introduction to the software, this class will help you make your images stand out.

Are you looking for a career opportunity in which you can work within the community, gain valuable experience and make a difference in the lives of children and families? Consider becoming a Professional Child Visitation Monitor. A position that is always in demand. Monitors earn \$45–\$60 an hour, depending on the case. Often times, based on issues of protection and safety, a judge will order that a child only have contact with a parent when a neutral third person is present during the visit.

The monitor's responsibility is to ensure the safety and well-being of the children involved. After completion of this course, monitors can apply at a visitation agency or work independently. This comprehensive course satisfies the State 24-hour training requirement. You will learn California State policies and procedures as well as your role as a monitor. Must be at least 21 years old and have a clean record.

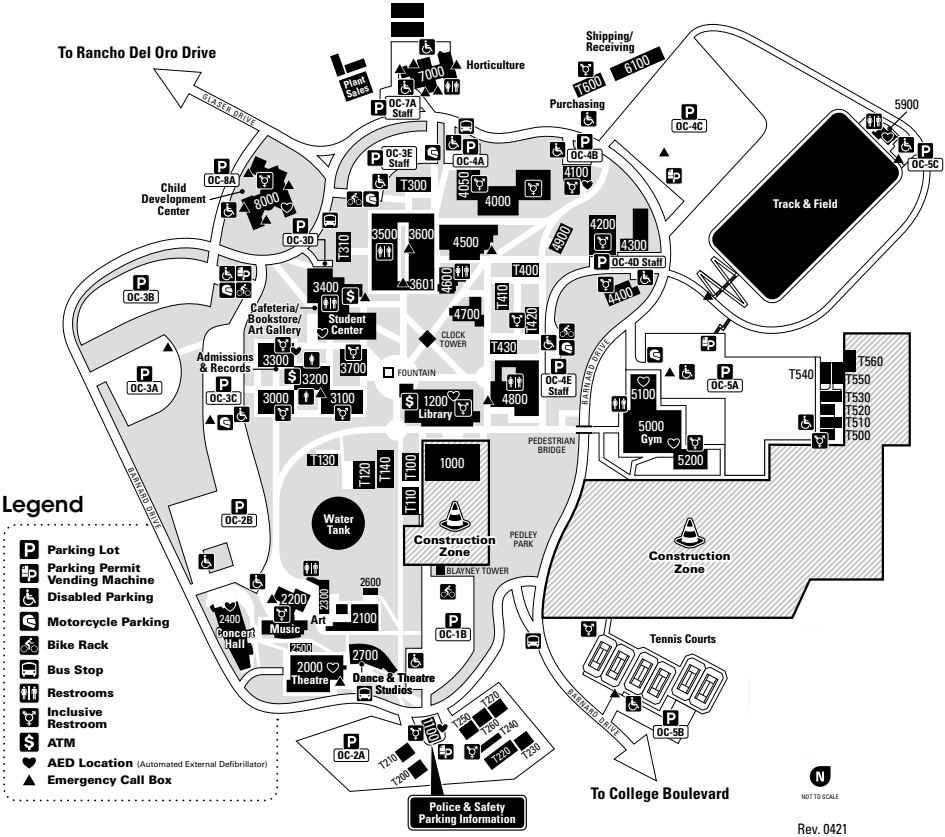

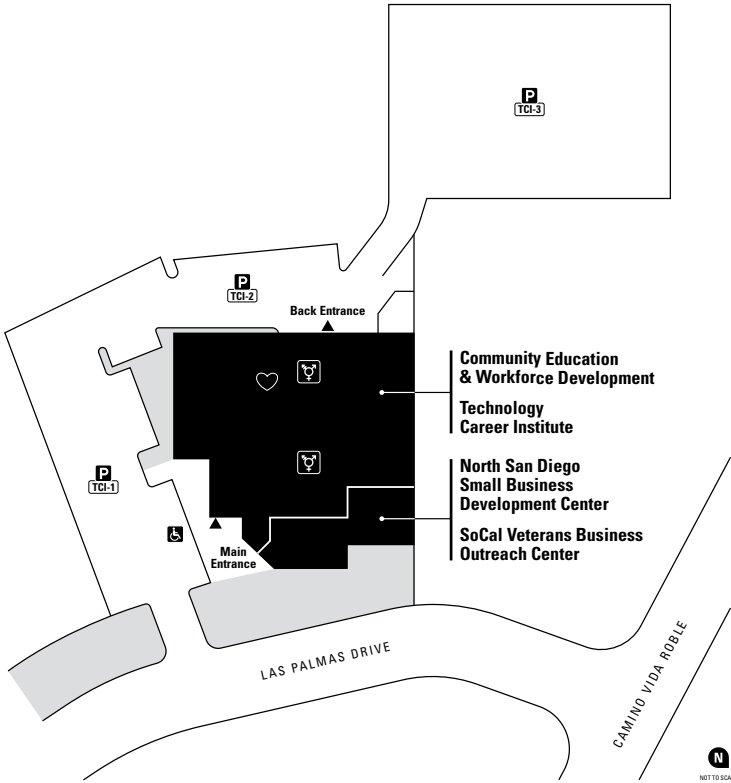

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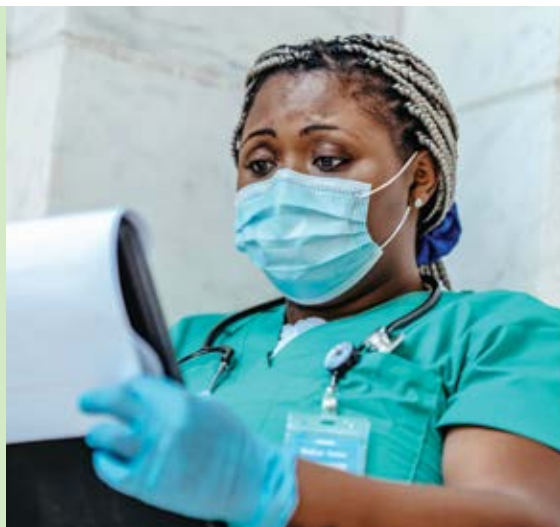
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
