IF YOU ARE A STUDENT WHO...

was registered in classes spring, summer, or fall 2021 and know your SURF ID number and password, you do not need to reapply for admission.

IF YOU ARE A NEW STUDENT...

or have not been registered in spring, summer, or fall 2021, you will need to apply for admission. Follow the steps below:

- → Apply for admission at miracosta.edu/apply.
 - After MiraCosta College processes your application (typically within 2–3 business days), you will receive an email with information about SURF, our online registration system accessible at surf.miracosta.edu. Student ID numbers (also known as SURF IDs) are required in order to use the online system, prior to registering for classes. SURF ID numbers are NOT sent to the students. Students are required to retrieve their SURF ID and create a password. Tutorials are available at miracosta.edu/tutorials.
- → Go to the appropriate section of the schedule to select your classes. When you register, you will be asked the class number of each class you wish to take, write down the class numbers, then go to surf.miracosta.edu to register for classes online. - → Students registering in Adult High School, High School Equivalency classes, or noncredit ESL may want to meet with a counselor prior to selecting and registering for classes.



If you have not retrieved your SURF ID number and have not created a password, you will need to do so prior to registering online:

Go to miracosta.edu/surfID.

You will need the email account you used while applying to MiraCosta College to create a password. If you do not know the email account you used when you applied or do not have an email account, you will need to contact the Student HelpDesk at 760.795.6655 or by email at **studenthelp@miracosta.edu** for assistance creating a password and accessing your account.



Be sure you know the 4-digit class numbers of the classes you want to add before you start.

- Go to surf.miracosta.edu.
- Click on log in and enter your SURF ID and password.
- Click on the Manage Classes tile.
- On the left panel select "Class Search and Enroll."
- Select the semester you are registering for.
- In the Search for Classes text box enter the 4-digit class number and click the Enter key.
- The search should return the class that you want—click on the class name to select it.
- Click on the small arrow on the right side of the page to continue registering for that class.
- You are now on Step 1 of 5: Select Academic Career. Select "Adult High School" or "Tuition-free Noncredit" and then click Accept to continue. Students may not be prompted to select a career if not needed.

- You are now on Step 2 of 5: Review Class Selection. Click the Next button with the arrow to continue.
- You are now on Step 3 of 5: Review Class Preferences. If you have a permission code, enter it here, otherwise leave it blank. Click Accept to continue.
- You are now on Step 4 of 5: Enroll or Add to Cart. Select Enroll to finish enrolling or select Add to Shopping Cart to add class to your shopping cart. Click Next to continue. Students are not enrolled in classes if they add the class to the shopping cart.
- You are now on Step 5 of 5: Review and Submit. Review the information and click Submit to finish.
- Respond to the pop-up window to confirm your submission. Select Yes to enroll in the class or to add class to the shopping cart. Students are not enrolled in classes if they add the class to the shopping cart. Select No to cancel.

 A confirmation message will display.

NOTE: If you added classes to the Shopping Cart you are not enrolled in the class(es). You must go to the Shopping Cart then select the classes you wish to enroll in and select Enroll. Select YES to enroll in the class.

OVERVIEWA Brief Description of Classes

Adult High School Diploma

MiraCosta College's Adult High School prepares adults for higher education and increased employability in a supportive, challenging, and accessible environment that respects and honors diversity. Upon entrance into the program, each student's previous coursework, skill levels, and academic and/or professional goals are determined in order to provide an individualized plan for goal attainment. Students must earn a total of 160 credits, with at least 20 credits in residence.

The Adult High School is fully accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Schools, and the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) through the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

Career & College Preparation

MiraCosta College offers career and college preparation for students who wish to increase their skills in preparation for college classes, for employment or advancement in the workplace, or for personal growth. These courses are offered in a variety of ways, including open enrollment, face-to-face, hybrid, and 100 percent online. (An open enrollment class means that students may enroll at any time throughout the semester.) Academic Skill classes include NCABE, NCENG, and NCMTH. Workforce Preparation classes are offered in our Short Term Voc department and include business office computer applications, employability skills, automotive technology, and courses to prepare students for entrylevel employment. Specific information is available on the Short-Term Vocational webpage at miracosta.edu/ shorttermvocational. These classes include NCWFP, NCBOT, and NCVOC.

Noncredit ESL (NCESL) English as a Second Language

The MiraCosta noncredit ESL program offers students a variety of learning opportunities to achieve proficiency in the English language and formulate and attain personal, academic, career or job, and/or civic goals. The noncredit ESL program provides seven levels of ESL at the Community Learning Center during morning, afternoon, and evening hours, as well as weekends. The program also offers citizenship, career-track ESL, conversation classes, computer and digital literacy classes, reading and writing skills-based classes, and open-entry distance learning.

General Noncredit

The goal of adult education in California is to provide citizens of every age and educational level the opportunity to develop civic responsibility, a realization of the human potential, effective human relationships, and economic self-sufficiency. General Noncredit continuing education at MiraCosta College includes the following areas:

Basic Skills for Adults with Developmental Disabilities

Courses specifically designed to provide individuals with life-skill proficiencies that are essential to the fulfillment of academic, vocational, and personal goals for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Contacting Student Accessibility Services (formerly DSPS) is encouraged prior to registration to ensure classroom accommodations can be provided. Health & Safety

Courses specifically designed to offer lifelong education to promote the health, safety, and the well-being of individuals.

Courses specifically designed to offer education in parenting, child development, and family relations in order to enhance the quality of home, family, career, and community life.

THINGS TO KNOW



Adding/Dropping Classes

Changes to your class schedule may be made online using SURF (surf.miracosta.edu) or in person* at the Admissions & Records Office at the Community Learning Center. You will not be mailed a confirmation of registration. Students are responsible for officially adding or dropping a class. If you decide not to continue in a class for which you have registered, it is your responsibility to drop the class officially by using SURF or by submitting a drop card to Admissions & Records. Attendance at First Class Meeting & Wait Lists

To ensure your place in a class, attend the first class meeting. Students in 100% online classes must log into Canvas and engage in course work during the first week to avoid being dropped for inactivity. Instructors may drop absent students to make room for students wishing to add the class from the wait list. While registering in SURF, students may select the wait list option for a full class. In order to add a class that has been wait listed, students will need to contact the instructor. If the instructor agrees to add the student to a class, they will provide the student with a permission number that the student can use to add the class in SURF. The instructor may also contact Admissions & Records to add the student.



Class Cancellations

Classes may be canceled due to insufficient enrollment. Every attempt will be made to contact students by email before the class meets. Students do not need to drop a canceled class.



Academic Accommodations

Students with disabilities, whether physical, learning, or psychological, who believe that they may need accommodations, are encouraged to contact Student Accessibility Services (formerly, DSPS) as soon as possible. Residency and Proficiency



To earn the diploma, students must demonstrate residency with at least 20 credits in attendance. They must also earn proficiency in English and mathematics through the successful completion of three AHS courses:

- HSENG 16-English Grammar 2
- HSENG 25-English 4
- HSMTH 21/HSMTH 30-Algebra 2/Geometry or the equivalent
- *Specific college credit courses may also be used to meet residency and proficiency requirements.

Noncredit Certificates



Certificates of Competency help students demonstrate achievement through the completion of a series of courses for personal or professional development, or as milestones of achievement in the pursuit of a diploma.

- Basic Education for Academic or Workforce Preparation, 3 classes
- Certificate of Competency: English Fundamentals—Grammar, 2 classes
- Certificate of Competency: English Fundamentals—Reading, 2 classes

CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY

Beginning Noncredit ESL

This entry-level certificate is designed to help students communicate in everyday life situations they will encounter in the community and at home, school, and work so they can meet their personal, academic, and career goals.

Intermediate Noncredit ESL

This intermediate-level certificate is designed to help students build on their abilities to communicate in English and to progress through the noncredit ESL program.

2 Required Courses

- NCESL 32—Level 5
- Choose one elective— NCESL 30, 33, 62A, 65, 81, 82

Advanced Noncredit ESL

This advanced-level certificate is designed to help students build on their abilities to communicate in English and to progress through the noncredit ESL program and transition into Adult High School/GED courses, credit courses, or employment.

2 Required Courses

- NCESL 45—Level 7
- Choose one elective— NCESL 30, 33, 62A, 62C, 65, 82

English Fundamentals—Reading

This certificate provides a supportive, noncredit, competency-based pathway for students wishing to improve their basic literacy and comprehension skills.

2 Required Courses

- Choose one—HSENG/NCENG 17 or NCABE 90
- HSENG/NCENG 21—Paragraph to Essay

English Fundamentals—Writing

This certificate provides a supportive, noncredit, competency-based pathway for students wishing to improve their basic composition skills.

2 Required Courses

- Choose one— HSENG/NCENG 17, 21 or NCABE 94
- HSENG/NCENG 22—Basic Composition: The 5 Paragraph Essay

English Fundamentals—Grammar

This certificate provides a supportive, noncredit, competency-based pathway for students wishing to improve their foundational English language and grammar skills.

2 Required Courses

- Choose one—HSENG/NCENG 15 or 16
- NCENG 30—Sentence Crafting

Basic Education for Academic or Workforce Preparation

This certificate is designed to help students review foundation skills in reading, writing, grammar, and mathematics.

3 Required Courses

- Choose one English— HSENG/NCENG 17, 21, 22, 23, or 25
- Choose one math— HSMTH/NCMTH 11, 12, 13, 20, 21
- Choose one elective— HSENG/NCENG 15, 16, 40 or NCVOC 42, 43, NCNUR 50, or HSWFP 11

High School Equivalency Preparation

This certificate is for students who have completed coursework in preparation for a high school equivalency (GED/HiSet) exams.

2 Required Courses

- Choose one—English NCENG 17-25, math NCMTH 11-21, or computers NCWFP 11
- NCABE 94—High School Equivalency Preparation

CERTIFICATES OF COMPLETION

Computer Applications— Microsoft Word

This certificate demonstrates that students have successfully completed beginning and intermediate courses in Microsoft Word that prepares them for employment.

Computer Applications— Microsoft Excel

This certificate demonstrates that students have successfully completed Beginning and Intermediate Microsoft Excel courses that prepare them for employment.

TYPES OF CLASSES

Classes in all delivery formats meet the same academic requirements. Students should be familiar with each format before registering to ensure they choose the classes that best fit their learning styles and academic needs.



Scheduled Online in ZOOM classes in noncredit meet online using a live videoconferencing tool (such as ZOOM) at all of the days and times indicated in the class listing. These classes *may* have additional instruction, coursework, and activities to be completed online.



Hybrid classes require meeting time online, as well as specific days and times on campus in a classroom. These classes provide a good balance between time on campus and learning online.



Online + ZOOM classes in noncredit require both scheduled online meetings (ZOOM) and independent online learning each week. For example, a class may meet for 3 hours of ZOOM time each week +3 hours weekly online. The online hours will be completed in an independent learning format.



Face-to-Face classes are scheduled on campus for a regular pattern of days and times. Canvas may be used as a supplement to on-campus learning in some classes.



Fully Online classes in noncredit require all instruction, coursework, and activities to be completed fully online. Classes offered 100 percent online have no face-to-face requirements allowing for the most flexibly in this independent learning format.





HyFlex classes give students the option of attending class in-person or participating via ZOOM. Students should be prepared to participate in the scheduled lecture on campus or online via ZOOM at the days/times/location indicated in the class listing.

What is ZOOM?

Many **noncredit** classes will utilize an online, live videoconferencing tool called ZOOM. Classes in ZOOM can be accessed for free on most computers, tablets, or mobile devices. It is recommended (but not required) to have a webcam and microphone if you are using a computer.

During scheduled or arranged ZOOM times, students should be prepared to interact with their instructors, just like they would have in a face-to-face class.

Scheduled online and combination classes will require that students be online at the same time as their instructors (synchronous instruction) for some of their school work, and other times students will work on their own time and at their own pace (asynchronous instruction). Fully online classes may offer optional ZOOM sessions for students to meet with instructors and get more help with the class.



To ZOOM, students can use a phone, tablet, or computer.




