Listening

Demonstrate comprehension of simplified spoken English and simple conversations.

- 1. Recognize words that signal differences between present, past and future.
- 2. Respond appropriately to simple instructions including requests for clarification.
- 3. Detect differences in meaning between statements and questions.

<u>Speaking</u>

Describe basic needs and relate common activities using clarification strategies when appropriate.

- 1. Express simple statements and questions in the present, past, or future tenses related to basic needs and common activities, using previously learned phrases or simple sentences.
- 2. Demonstrate the ability to communicate simple personal and emergency information.
- 3. Employ simple clarification requests to determine meaning of question or statement.

Reading

Construct meaning from simplified print materials on familiar topics.

- 1. Identify basic words, phrases, and numerical information.
- 2. Interpret short, simplified narrative paragraphs on familiar topics and sequence of events.
- 3. Examine simple authentic documents (e.g. *ads, schedules, forms, food coupons, Web pages, and standardized tests*) to locate specific information.

<u>Writing</u>

Produce sentences to form a paragraph and complete forms requiring some detail.

- 1. Write a simple paragraph based on personal experience or a simple theme with questions (5 8 sentences).
- 2. Use some detailed biographical or personal information to complete forms.
- 3. Write a simple note or message (e.g. to a landlord about a repair, or a child's teacher about an illness).
- 4. Modify a series of sentences for errors in capitalization, punctuation, and spelling.
