FATS Interactive Training

Objective:

Provide Training on the PRISim interactive training system. This system focuses on providing a series of shoot and no shoot interactive incidents. This system brings the officer(s) through several interactive stories dependent on how the officer reacts. The officer(s) will experience at least 3-4 interactions and instructors will provide a briefing after each incident consistent with Department Policies and Procedures.

Procedures

Individual Officers will experience a variety of situations which involve shoot and no-shoot incidents including an active shooter incident. Incidents are interactive and designed to react differently according to how the officer reacts. An instructor briefing will be conducted with each officer in accordance with Department Policies and Procedures.

Once each officer has gone through each of the situations, the officer will be paired with another officer and given additional situations as officers respond. The situation will be replayed as a briefing is conducted for officers to assess if they made the correct decision or could have made a better decision.
