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

Different Ways to Earn College Credit in High School

Dual Enrollment CCAP and Non-CCAP

Concurrent Enrollment

- College classes
- Final grade appears on MiraCosta transcript. Credits are accepted at UC/CSUs and often accepted by other colleges.
- HS counselor helps determine if credit can be applied toward HS graduation requirements
- MiraCosta student support resources available for free
- Students take courses at their high school or online with other HS students
- No cost to student (no enrollment fees, Health fee, Student Center fee, or textbook costs)
- Registration process is managed by the HS and MiraCosta staff

- Students take courses on MiraCosta campus or online with college students
- Enrollment fees are waived; students pay Health Fee (\$21) and textbook/ materials fees (if any)
- Students register themselves.

Articulation (Credit by Exam)

- Students earn college credit if they earn an A or B in their high school course and on the final exam/project.
- Only certain courses in CTE areas
- Final exam grade shown on MiraCosta transcript with a Credit By Exam notation.
- Credit may be applicable towards certificates, degrees, and/or transfer.
- No cost to student

IGETC & CAL-GETC Overview

Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (<u>IGETC</u>): describes the pattern of courses that allows a student to transfer from a California community college to a CSU or UC campus having completed lower division general education requirements.

California General Education Transfer Curriculum (<u>Cal-GETC</u>): singular general education pathway for California Community College students to fulfill general education requirements for transfer to both CSU and UC.




Interest Forms

- Each school creates and maintains its own interest form.
- Interest forms allow students to communicate their desired dual enrollment courses to their high school counselors.
 - This process enables counselors to initiate meaningful conversations with their students about the realm of early college credit and setting clear expectations for the rigor and requirements of college-level courses
- When a high school counselor moves a student from the <u>interest form</u> to the (shared) **Dual Enrollment Registration Sheet**, they are notifying MiraCosta that the student is approved to take Dual Enrollment courses.
 - Interest forms help identify which students may need additional registration support

## **Transcript Process**



#### **Dual Enrollment**

 As part of our CCAP agreement, Admissions & **Records will automatically** send final transcripts to OUSD registrars at the end of the semester.





#### **Concurrent Enrollment**

• Students will need to request their final transcripts. • The first two transcripts ever requested are free; thereafter they are \$5 per copy and a \$2 handling fee will be added to the transcript requests submitted through Parchment.

## How to Drop a Class

#### A few options for Dual Enrollment Courses:


- Students and/or counselors can send an email to dualenroll@miracosta.edu
  - Must contain:
    - A clear request to be dropped
    - Student's full name
    - SURF ID
    - Class name and section number
- Students can drop themselves through their <u>SURF</u> account.
- Counselors can add a comment on the shared Registration Spreadsheet in the "OUSD Comments" column.

#### Note: Concurrent Enrollment

Students enrolled in courses concurrently need to drop themselves through their SURF account

## FERPA The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974

A federal law that protects the privacy of educational records of all students enrolled in schools beyond the high school level.

MCC staff and faculty are unable to provide student-specific information to anyone unless the student has given their consent.



Once a student applies to college, the rights on their student record moves from the parent to the student, regardless of the student's age.

## Important Class Deadlines

#### **01** Add/Drop Deadline (10% of course)

- Adding a student after this deadline requires instructor and dean approval (only for extenuating circumstances).
- Dropping a class after the add/drop deadline results in a W grade (withdrawal)

#### **02** Withdrawal (W) Deadline (75% of course)

- Students can drop and receive a W up to the 75%
- After the 75% deadline the student is required to receive an evaluative grade (A,B,C,D,F,P or NP).







## **Financial Aid Implications**

- Dual enrollment courses count as college courses. They are included in a student's college GPA and factor into total units attempted and completed.
- To be eligible for financial aid in college, students must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and complete 66.7% of courses attempted with an "A", "B", "C", "D", or "P."
- Failing grades, drops, withdrawals, and incompletes will lower the completion percentage and may have future financial aid implications.
- The important thing to keep in mind is that successful completion of college courses in high school can help students graduate from college earlier.






## Canvas

Interactive Learning Management System MCC uses (Similar to Google Classroom)

- Even if class meets in person, students still have a "class" in Canvas
- Once students enroll, they can access their course in Canvas, Courses are usually "published" the week before classes begin
- The goal is to have students log into Canvas before classes start
- All emails, announcements and assignments will be posted in Canvas.
- Instructors post their syllabus in Canvasa roadmap to the semester
