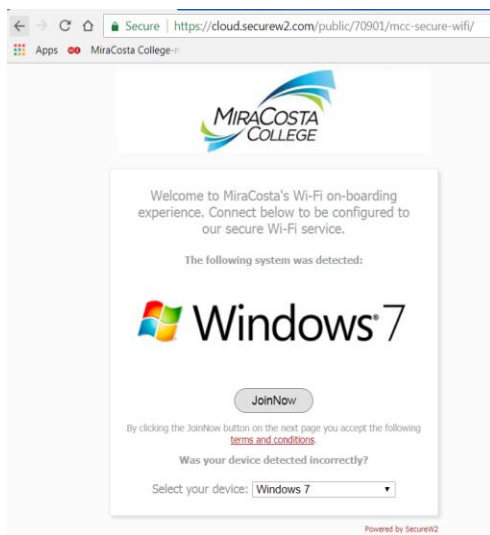


# MiraCosta College Secure Wi-Fi device On-boarding

Starting the process of on-boarding your device to MiraCosta's secure network requires a couple pre-requisites. Please make sure you have the following before starting.

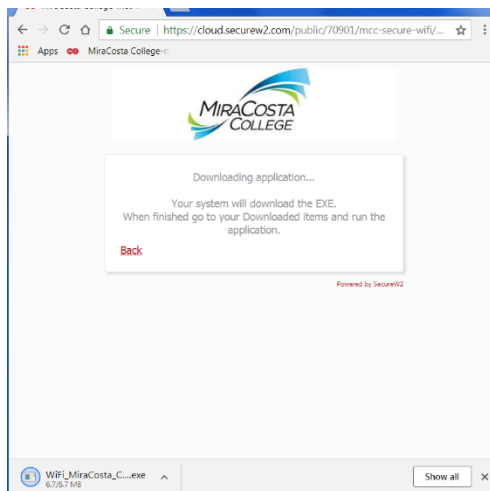
- A valid account (students will use their SURF login, employees will use their Outlook account.)
- An account with administrative rights on your computer, some configuration might require this.
- Your device will need to be connected to MiraCosta's open non-secure MiraCosta-WIFI network.

Launch a browser on your device, and go to <https://cloud.securew2.com/public/70901/mcc-secure-wifi/>



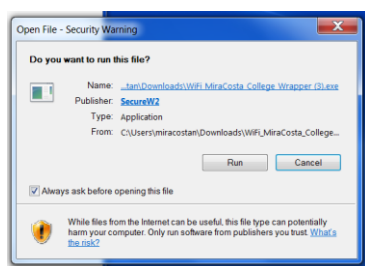
- You should see this webpage.
- The system should recognize that you are Win7


Click the 'JoinNow' button, the computer will either start downloading a small helper file or will automatically download it. You will need to double click on this file, so make sure you save it to a findable location.

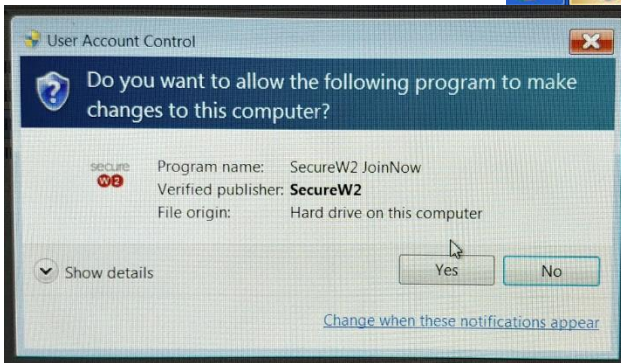


- Chrome will show your file in the bottom left hand side of the screen.
- Firefox will download the file to your 'downloads' folder.

Double clicking the file should bring up a warning prompt, click 'Run'.

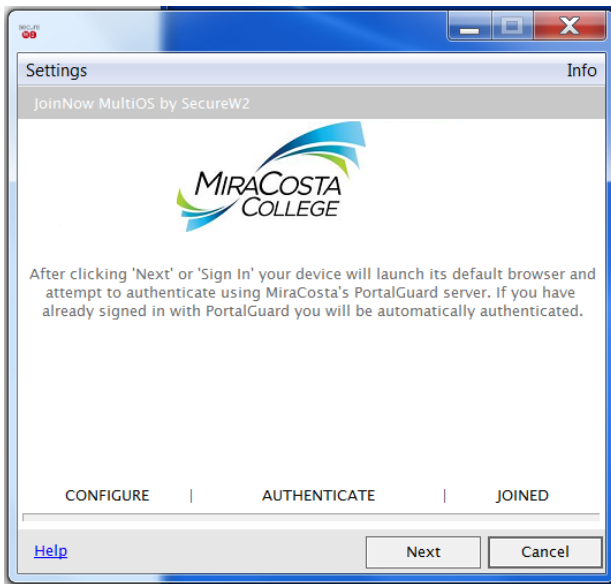


Depending on how your computer is configured you may be required to give administrative consent to run the program. You will see a small shield in the taskbar  click the shield and you should get a security prompt.



Click 'Yes' to allow the program to run.

Your computer will launch the program and start the on-boarding process.



- This is the little helper program that will authorize you,
- obtain your certificates and
- configure your device for our network.
- The program will provide you error messages if something goes wrong.

When the process completes you will see 'Joined...' and a 'Done' button. Click done, your computer is authorized and connected to MiraCosta's secure network.
