### VI. Updates and discussion on major spring MOE Goals

Members will provide updates on and discuss next steps for committee goals requiring the most significant effort this spring.

A. **Close current online ed plan and start new 3-year online education plan** in coordination with college education plan development. (Julius)

This goal has been pushed to 2026-27 as the college's Education Futures Plan continues to be developed.

B. **Support Distance Education (DE) Certification** workgroup. (Julius/Khan)

Julius and Khan will lead a discussion on eligibility and procedures for waiving module completion during the certification process. Julius and Khan will also solicit feedback on the use of student personas generated from student data within the certification modules.

C. Revisit institutional practice/guidance around **student participation in Zoom**. (Julius)

Julius will lead the committee in reviewing current college documents and feedback from this subcommittee so far.

C. **Build Hybrid/HyFlex resources**- with a focus on Hyflex. (Silva/Khan)

D. Provide **faculty support on accessibility**, especially with the spring 2026 federal deadline for compliance. (Khan)

E. Provide more **Flex workshops** and other forms of direct faculty professional learning. (Khan)

Work on this goal continues in the form of PD sessions and webinars being offered throughout the spring term on Hyflex teaching and Accessibility.

F. **Critical eye on Canvas**; advocacy for and building on faculty and student perspectives. (Khan)

Khan will lead on discussion on Instructure's current and planned deployment of AI features in Canvas.

VIII. **DesignPLUS Train and Play Series (Khan)**

Khan will give an overview of the Spring 26 Train and Play series, which offers faculty training and one on one support in using the new DesignPLUS tool to create polished, engaging, and accessible courses.
