RESOLVED, we as the Associated Student Government of MiraCosta College will advocate on behalf of students when their voices are being silenced, AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, we as the Associate Student Government of MiraCosta College will continue to have sensitivity trainings for members; AND BE IT FURTHER
