Resolution in Support of MiraCosta Community College District Bond Election – In Favor of  
Proposition --

WHEREAS, it has been more than 50 years since MiraCosta College passed a bond to repair or improve our facilities. We need to repair and upgrade our college campuses so we can continue to serve our community well for the decades to come by providing a high-quality education for local students;
