Question #14: The number of certificates submitted this year (396) is significantly lower than in prior cycles. That is because the college received clarification from ACCJC personnel in spring 2016 that the number of certificates submitted should not include CSU and IGETC certificates. In prior years, both the number submitted and the institutional standard were based on including those awards. During Fall 2016, the college correctly reported the lower series of numbers in its Accreditation Self Evaluation Report and in Spring 2017 reassessed its institutional set standard (now 364) to more accurately reflect the type of awards reported.

The data included in this report are certified as a complete and accurate representation of the reporting institution.

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
