

Should the superintendent/president be unable to perform the duties of the position, the duties and responsibilities delegated in Board Policy 2430, Delegation of Authority, shall be delegated to the vice president with the most years of service who is available and able to assume the duties until either the superintendent/president is able to be fully functional or the Board of Trustees takes a formal action concerning the delegation.
