## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

3525: Skateboards, Roller Skates, Bicycles, and Other Recreational Wheeled Vehicles

Skateboarding, or the use of any other recreational wheeled vehicles, is prohibited by policy at all times on all MiraCosta Community College District sites. This procedure applies to the entire property of each campus and includes roads, sidewalks, parking lots, and/or areas maintained by the district.

Based on concerns for the safety of skateboarders and pedestrians, as well as for risk and liability issues, the following restrictions are applied:

- A) Riding skateboards is prohibited on all campus property at all times.
- B) Roller skates, scooters, razor scooters, hover boards, all shoes featuring wheels housed in the heel, and devices of a similar nature are included in this section and prohibited on all campus property.

Bicycles can be ridden on roadways, but not on sidewalks or other areas maintained by the district.

Any district public safety personnel may warn or cite any person who is in violation of this administrative procedure.

This policy does not prohibit use of wheeled devices by the physically disabled or by any employee in the district engaged in the performance of their assigned duties.
