

**Library**

The library and information hubs will offer a full range of library resources and services.

The primary aim of the library is to provide information literacy instruction and a balanced collection of materials to support the curriculum. In addition, the library seeks to provide community members with opportunities for personal and cultural enrichment.

The selection and evaluation of materials in a wide variety of formats will be based on curricular demands, recommendations of current professional review sources, and suggestions from members of the college community.

The library will support online learners by providing online library resources, as well as library and instructional support, to students twenty-four hours a day, seven days per week.

All faculty, staff, enrolled students, and those with emeritus/Gold Circle status may borrow materials with approved identification. Area residents, including high school students, may borrow materials with the purchase of a community patron card.

**Learning Support Services**

The college offers multiple learning centers that provide instructional support services to students enrolled in academic courses; support may be specific to a course or may be related to basic skills in reading, writing, and math.

**Math Learning Center**

The Math Learning Center (MLC) provides assistance to all MiraCosta College math students through an extensive drop-in tutoring program. The MLC also provides a make-up/DSPS testing facility to accommodate students and faculty, a large selection of textbooks and calculators for use in the MLC, and computer stations for students to use to complete online homework.

**Tutoring and Academic Support Center**

The Tutoring and Academic Support Center (TASC) is committed to enhancing student retention and success by providing assistance to students through innovative academic

support services with individual and group tutoring, supplemental instruction, self-help materials, and student success workshops.

## **Writing Center**

The Writing Center (WC) is a safe place for writers of all backgrounds seeking to improve their writing. The WC encourages students to build and hone their writing, reading, and speaking skills to encourage academic success through friendly, supportive, and constructive dialogue.
