

**Office of Primary Responsibility: Student Health Services****Scope of Services**

Services provided for students by the Student Health Services include but are not limited to:

- A. Clinical Care Services
  - 1. Assessment, intervention, and referral for health services.
  - 2. First aid and basic emergency care.
  - 3. Health appraisal.
  - 4. Communicable disease control.
- B. Mental Health Services
  - 1. Crisis management.
  - 2. Short-term psychological counseling.
  - 3. Alcohol/drug counseling.
  - 4. Eating-disorders counseling.
  - 5. Stress management.
  - 6. Suicide prevention.
  - 7. Sexual harassment/assault-recovery counseling program.
  - 8. Mental health assessment.
- C. Special Services
  - 1. Health education and promotion.
  - 2. Teaching and research.

3. Student insurance information.
4. Environmental health and safety, including illness and injury prevention.

D. Support Services

1. Maintenance of health records in a confidential and ethical manner.
2. Laboratory: Student Health Services may provide Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments- waived in-house laboratory testing and obtains specimens to be sent for testing provided by a licensed, contracted laboratory.
3. Referrals may be provided for radiology, dental, optometric and other services not available internally.
4. Pharmacy services: Student Health Services may provide over-the-counter medications. Prescription medications ordered by a licensed physician or nurse practitioner shall be dispensed by the pharmacy of the student's choice within the community.

E. Personnel

1. Clinical services, including nursing, medical, and mental health services, shall be provided by qualified and appropriately licensed health care professionals.
