### Certificates of Proficiency

Certificates of Proficiency at MiraCosta College are designed to be a foundational step on the career ladder. These short-term certificates require fewer than 16 units of coursework and provide an introduction to a specific aspect of a trade or occupation. They are ideal for individuals who want to:

- Explore a potential career path
- Boost competitiveness for entry-level positions
- Enter an industry and continue their education while working

In most cases, courses completed for these certificates can also be applied toward a certificate of achievement and an associate degree.

### Certificates of Achievement

Certificates of Achievement are designed to quickly prepare students for immediate employment in specific career areas. The total number of units required varies by discipline, with a minimum of just 12 units—equivalent to only three classes. These certificates offer a streamlined pathway to job readiness and can be a stepping stone toward further education.

Students who earn a Certificate of Achievement can also choose to pursue an associate degree\* in the same field by completing additional general education courses. In some fields, credits earned may even be transferable toward a bachelor's degree, providing flexible options for continued academic and career advancement.

### Other Services

MiraCosta College students have access to career counseling, placement assistance for full-time and part-time jobs, financial aid, internships, affordable child care, tutoring, and training facilities. All first-time college students, taking 12 units or more per semester, also qualify for free college.
