



TRANSCRIPT GUIDE Noncredit (Continuing Education) Coursework Completed Prior to Spring 2002

MiraCosta College, formerly Oceanside-Carlsbad College (until July 1965), was established in 1934 as a part of the Oceanside-Carlsbad Community College District. In July of 1976, the Oceanside-Carlsbad Community College District became the MiraCosta Community College District.

MiraCosta College is a semester-system, two-year public California Community College, officially accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

The MiraCosta College Adult High School is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

Course Naming Conventions Prior to Spring 2002

HSDP An HSDP prefix to a course number indicates an Adult High School course. Credit counts towards adult high school diploma only.

Prior to spring 2002 Noncredit (Continuing Education) courses did not adhere to a specific naming convention. Courses do not apply to the associate degree and no units are earned. Not intended for transfer to a four-year college or university. **Courses that are not graded will appear on the transcript without a grade symbol.**
