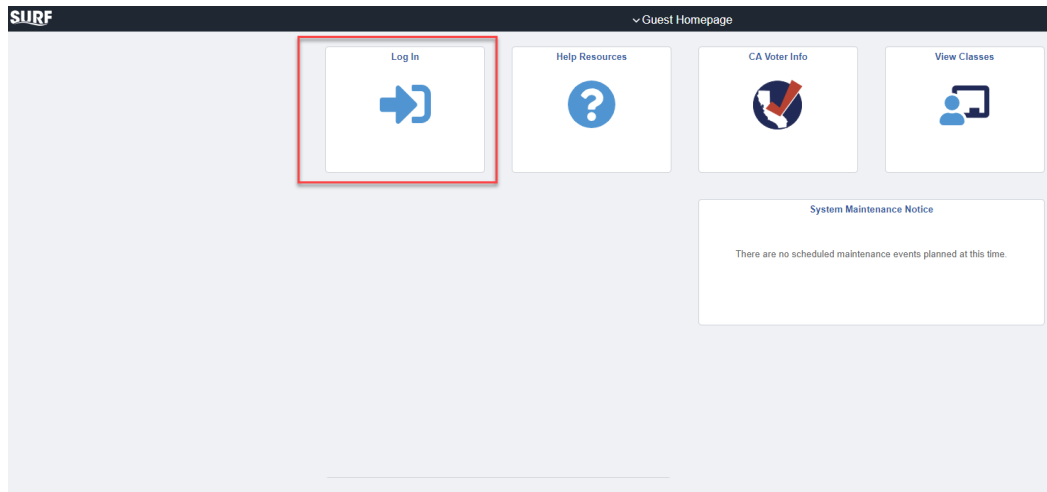
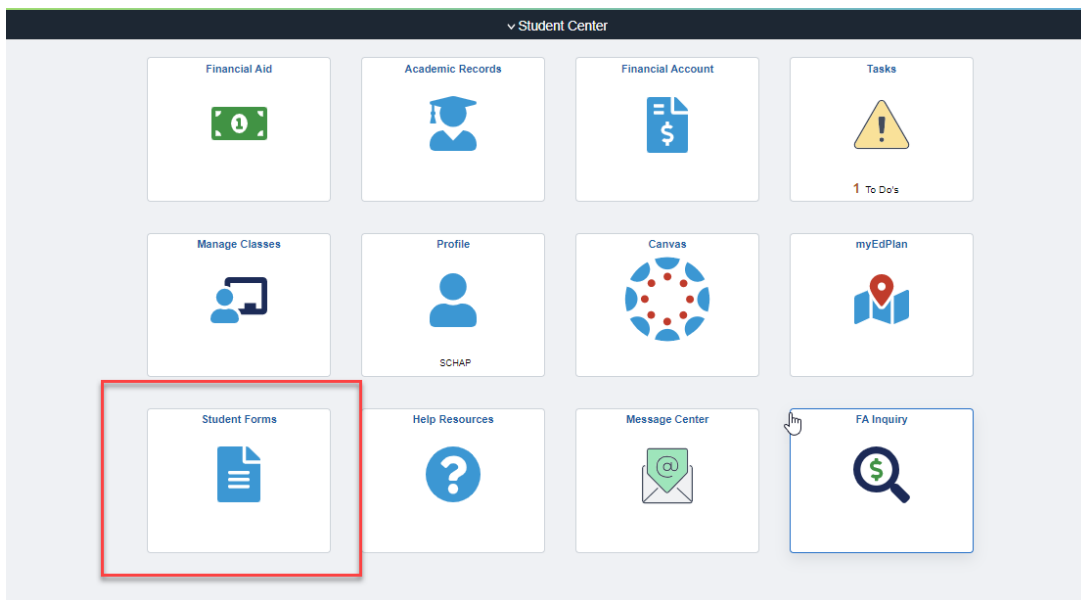


How to get to the Emergency Grant in SURF

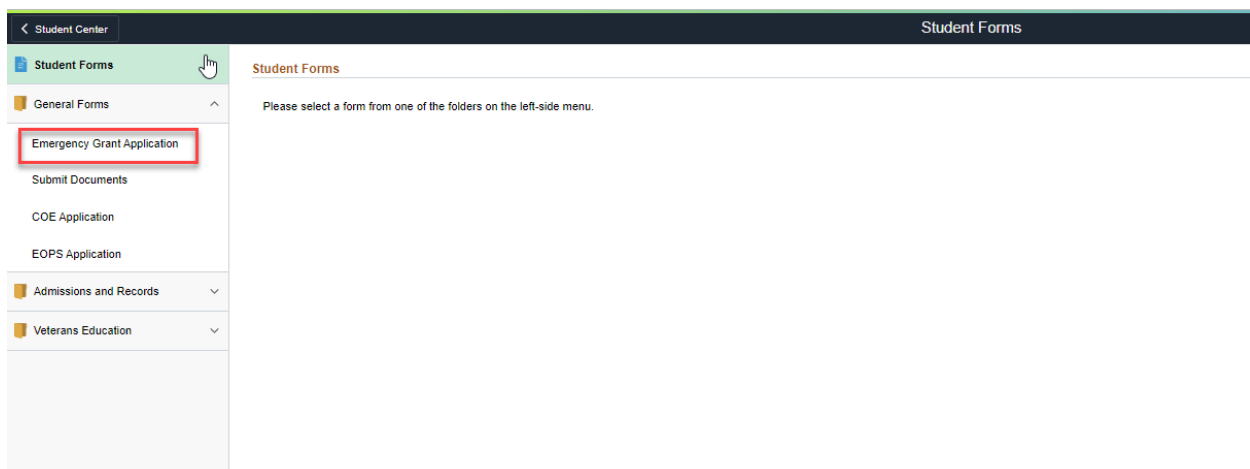
1. Log in to Surf (OR click [here](#) to be taken directly to the form in Surf):



2. Select **Student Forms**:



3. Select **General Forms** then **Emergency Grant Application**

MiraCosta is currently accepting Emergency Grant Applications for the Spring 2023 semester. Students are eligible to receive the emergency grant (up to \$1,000) one time per semester while funds are available. We will consider applications in order of receipt. **PLEASE SUBMIT ONE APPLICATION ONLY.**

IMPORTANT: Only **CURRENTLY** enrolled students in at least one course at MiraCosta College are eligible for this Emergency Grant. We will begin processing applications and verifying enrollment starting in two weeks. If approved, payment will then be made within 2-3 weeks after processing is complete.

Due to the available funding sources, permanent MiraCosta employees who are enrolled in courses are **NOT** eligible for Emergency Grant funding. If you are a permanent employee and applied in error, please notify MCCFinaid@mircosta.edu.

This form is **NOT** for emergency response situations. If this is an emergency that involves risk of harm to self or others, please contact College Police at 760-795-6640 or dial 911.

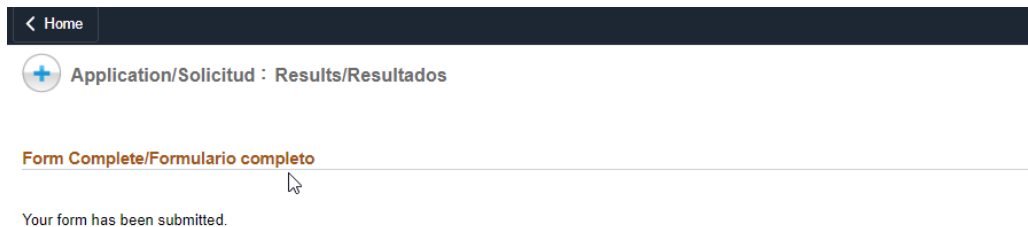

We are currently accepting applications for Spring 2023 **while funds are available**. We will consider applications in order of receipt and will begin processing applications and verifying enrollment starting on February 3, 2023. If approved, payment will then be made within 2-3 weeks.

Permanent MiraCosta employees are **NOT** eligible for Emergency Grant funding. If you are an employee and have applied in error, please notify MCCFinaid@miracosta.edu.

In order to be eligible for a [BankMobile](#) account, students must have an active FAFSA application and/or a CA Dream Act application on file and meet the age requirement of 18 years or older. If you are not eligible for [BankMobile](#), a check will be created and sent to your mailing address on file in SURF in the coming weeks. Please make sure to [update your address in SURF](#) as soon as possible if needed.
